Fabrication is carried out to the highest possible standard in accordance with ASMI B31.3. All welders are coded to our own qualified weld procedures and in accordance with ASME IX and BSEN 288.

Our Head Office is situated at Unit S1C Tursdale Industrial estate Bowburn County Durham DH6 5PG. We operate at clients sites as required.
